Craig Zimring of Georgia Tech will address the areas of day-to-day operations that our membership could improve on. From the College of Architecture, Mr. Zimring looks at the psychological aspects of winning within your professional career path as well as getting your FM agenda in line with your management team and company objectives. An environmental psychologist, Craig Zimring is an associate professor of architecture and of psychology at Georgia Tech. He was Vice-Chair of the Environmental Design Research Association and has won six awards for his research.
